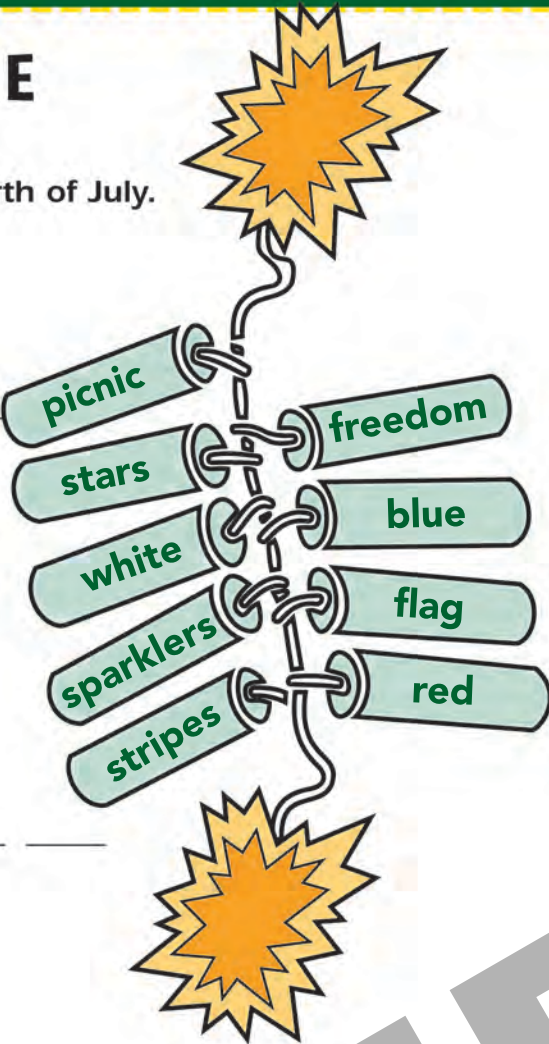

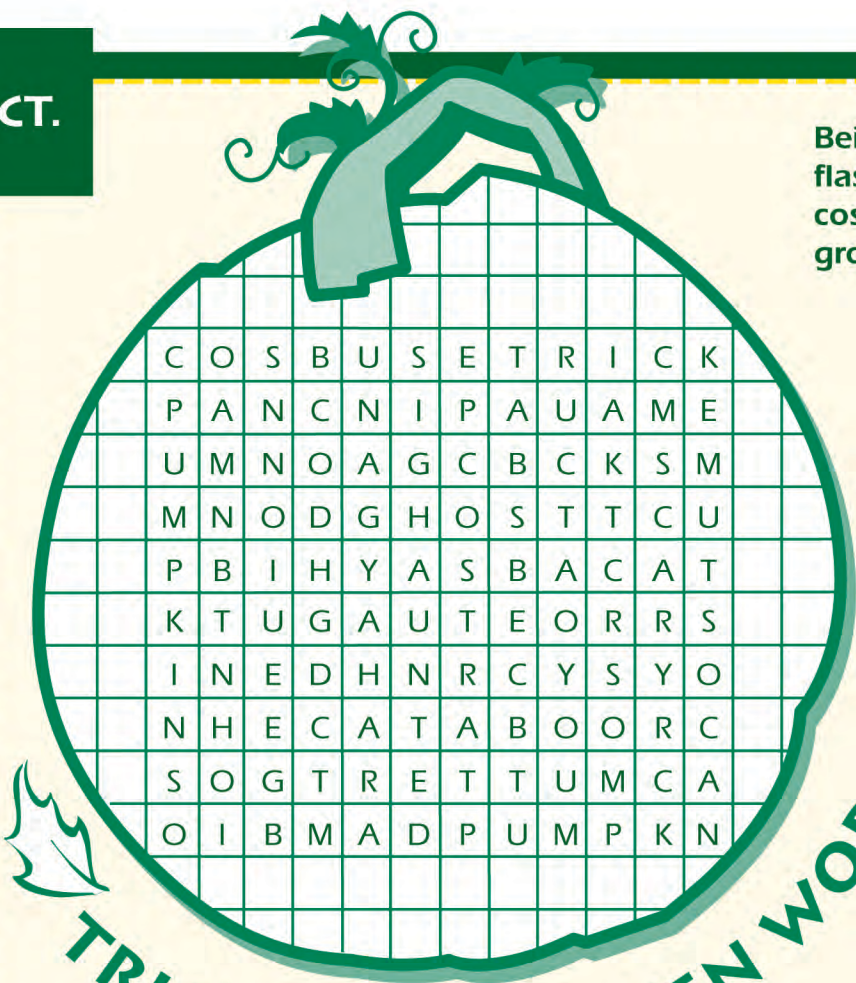
Let's Celebrate Holiday Fire Safety

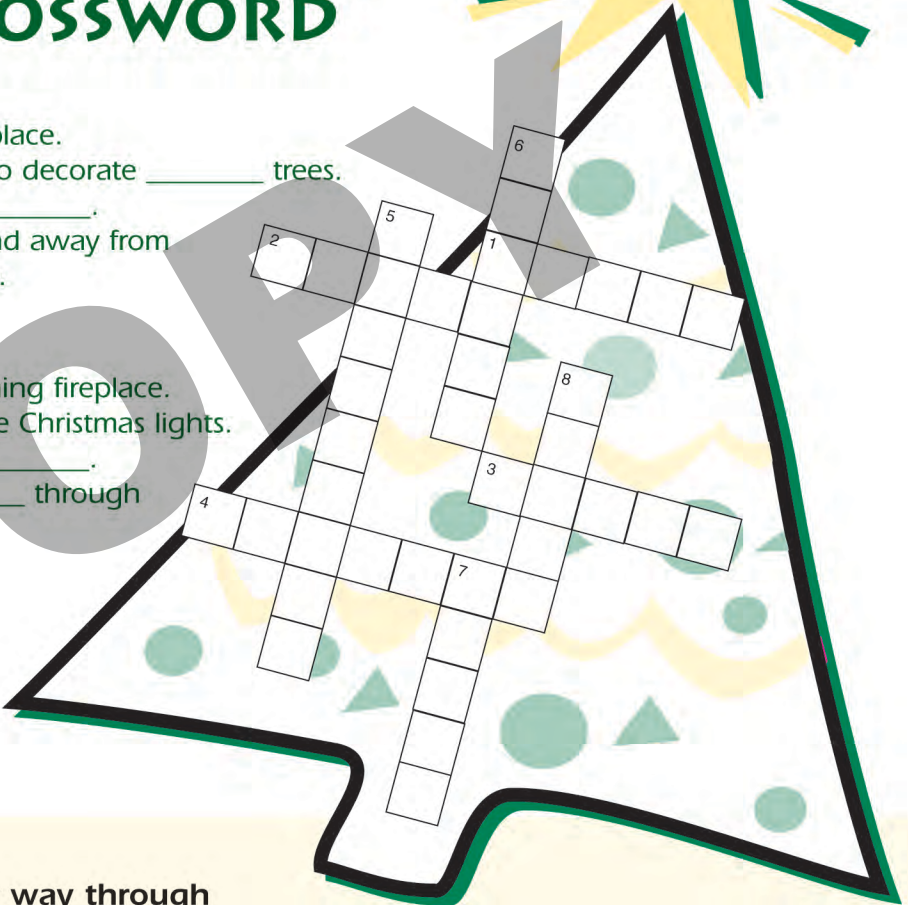

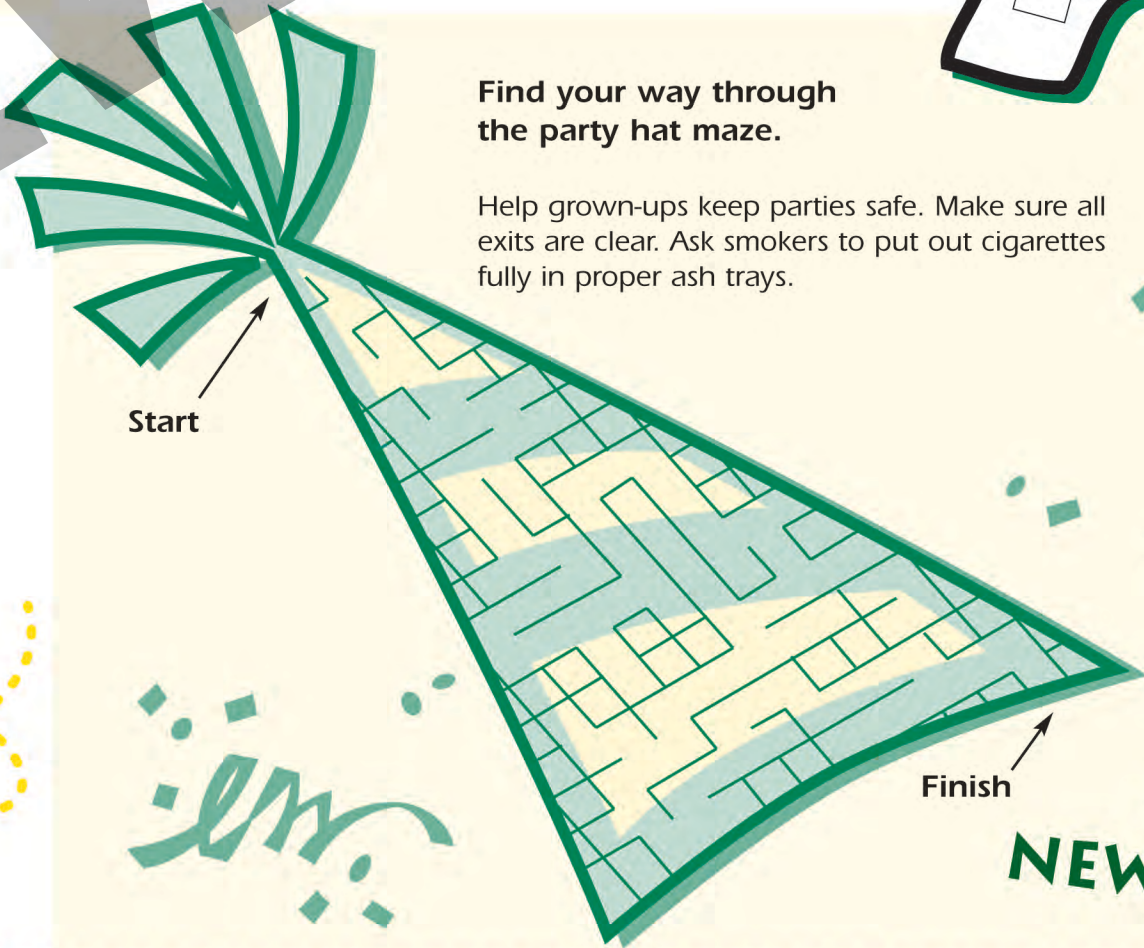
