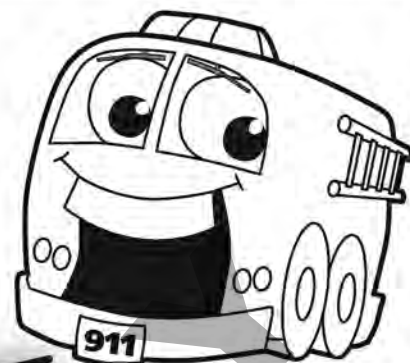

sound your smoke alarm makes.

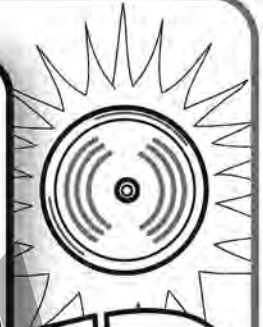

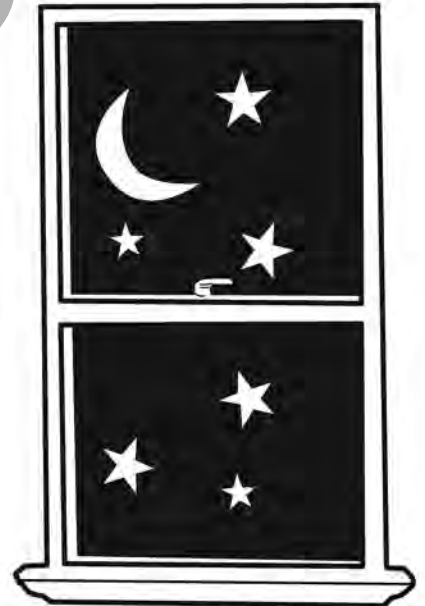




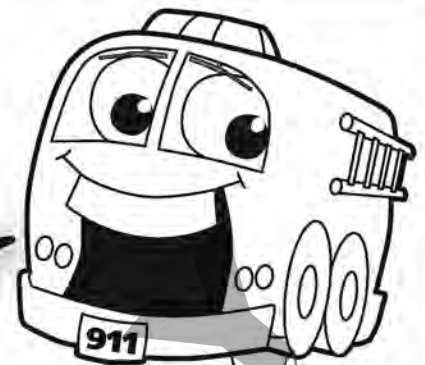
Make sure your smoke alarm is loud enough to wake you up even if you're in a deep sleep.



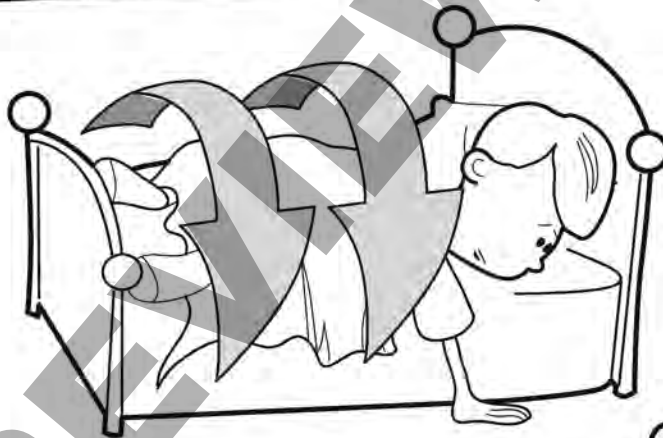
BEEP BEEP BEEP

Roll out of bed!

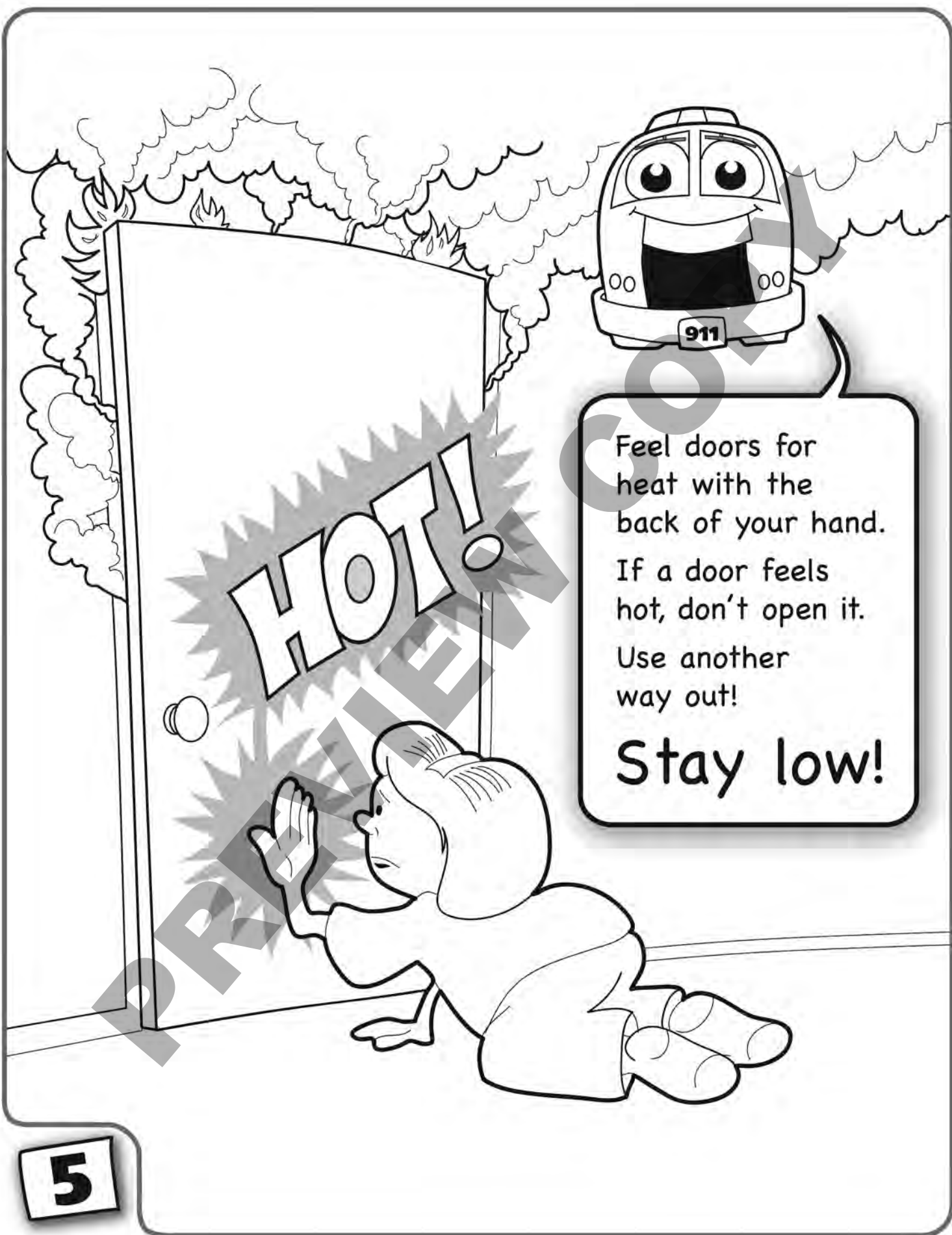

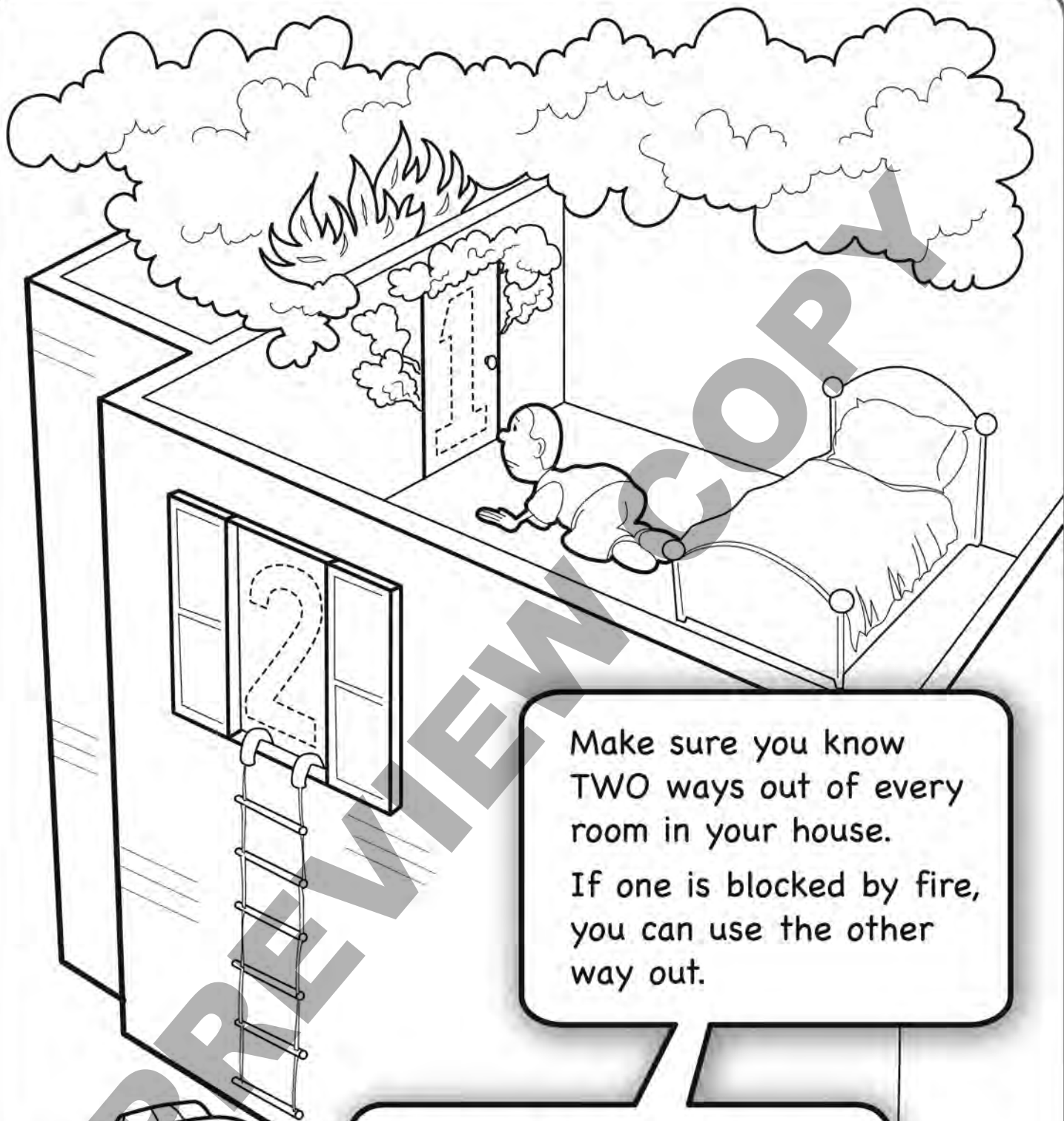

that show his two ways out.



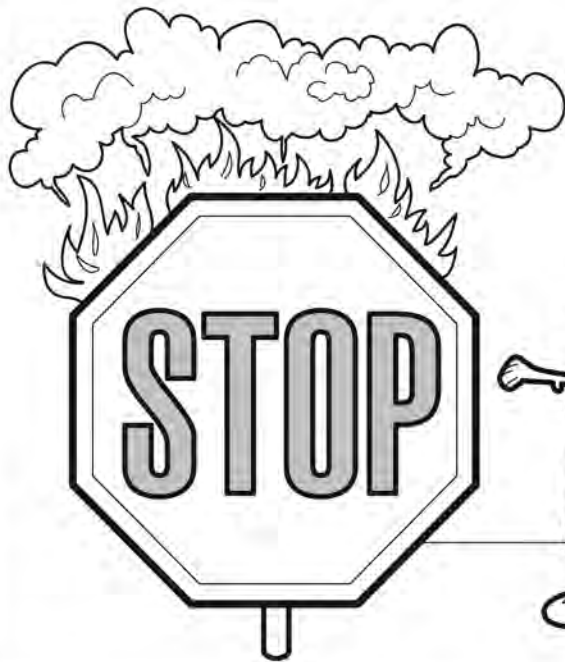
Smoke rises. Crawl

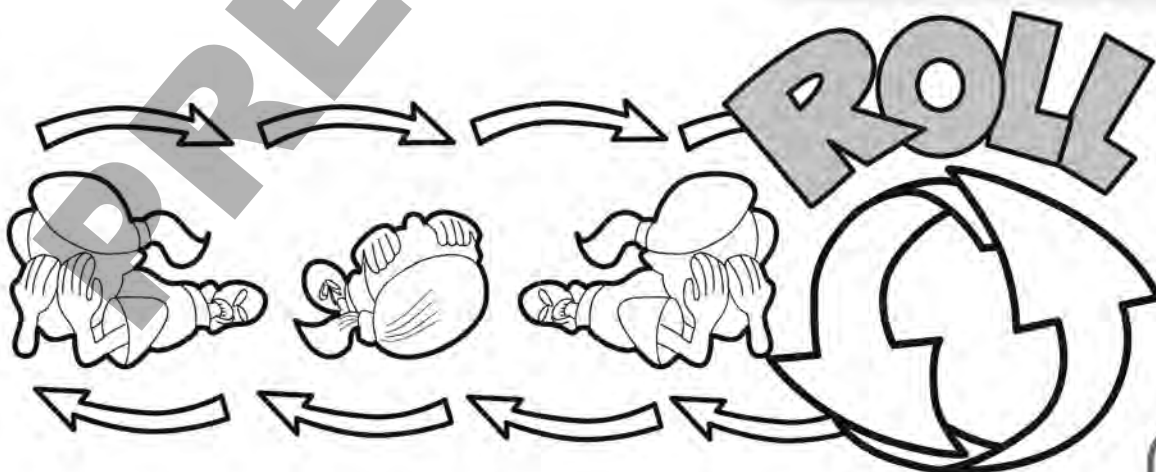

Have a safe meeting place where you and everyone in your family will go if there is a fire. That way you'll know that everyone is out safely.

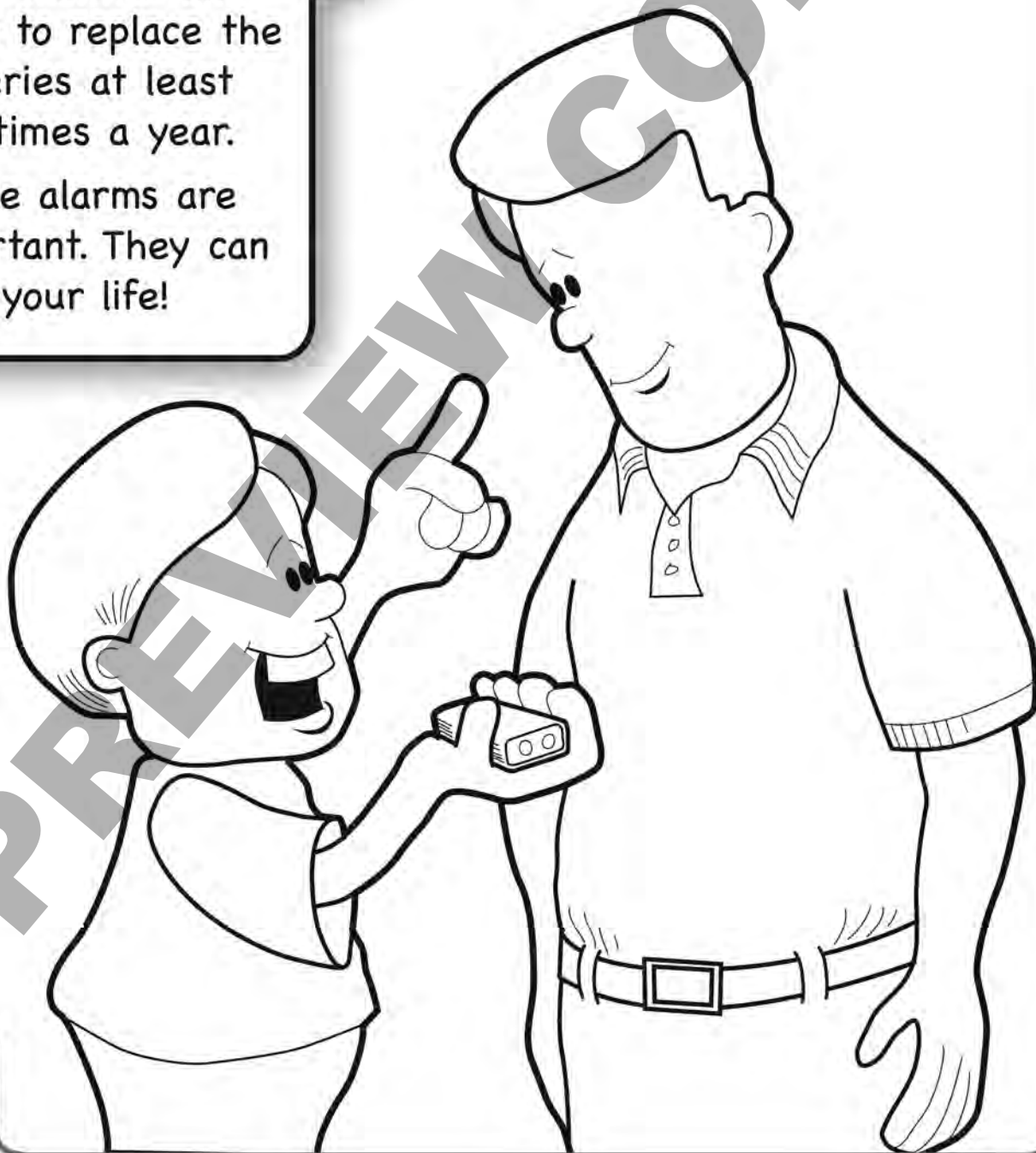
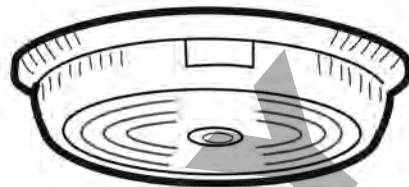
Once you're out, never go back inside a burning building for any reason! Favorite toys can be replaced, but YOU can never be replaced!



NEW YEAR GO BACK INSIDE



Remind grown-ups to test smoke alarms every month. Tell them to replace the batteries at least two times a year. Smoke alarms are important. They can save your life!

else.





Remind grown-ups to have a fire escape plan. Practice your plan together. Have fire drills during the day and night.
