Never play with matches or lighters! If your younger brothers or sisters play with matches or lighters go tell an adult!



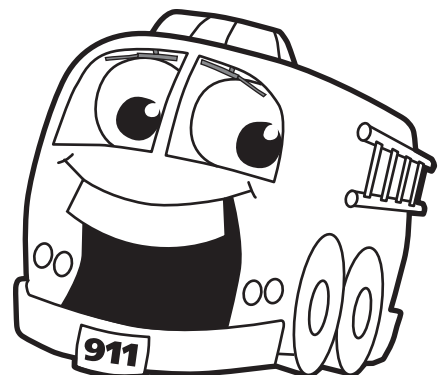


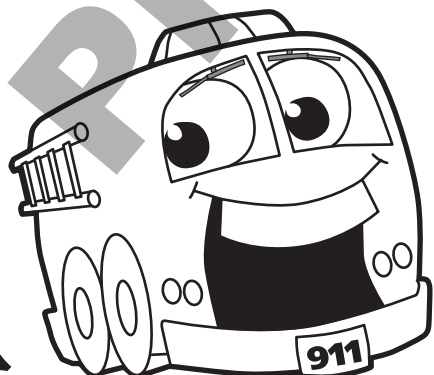
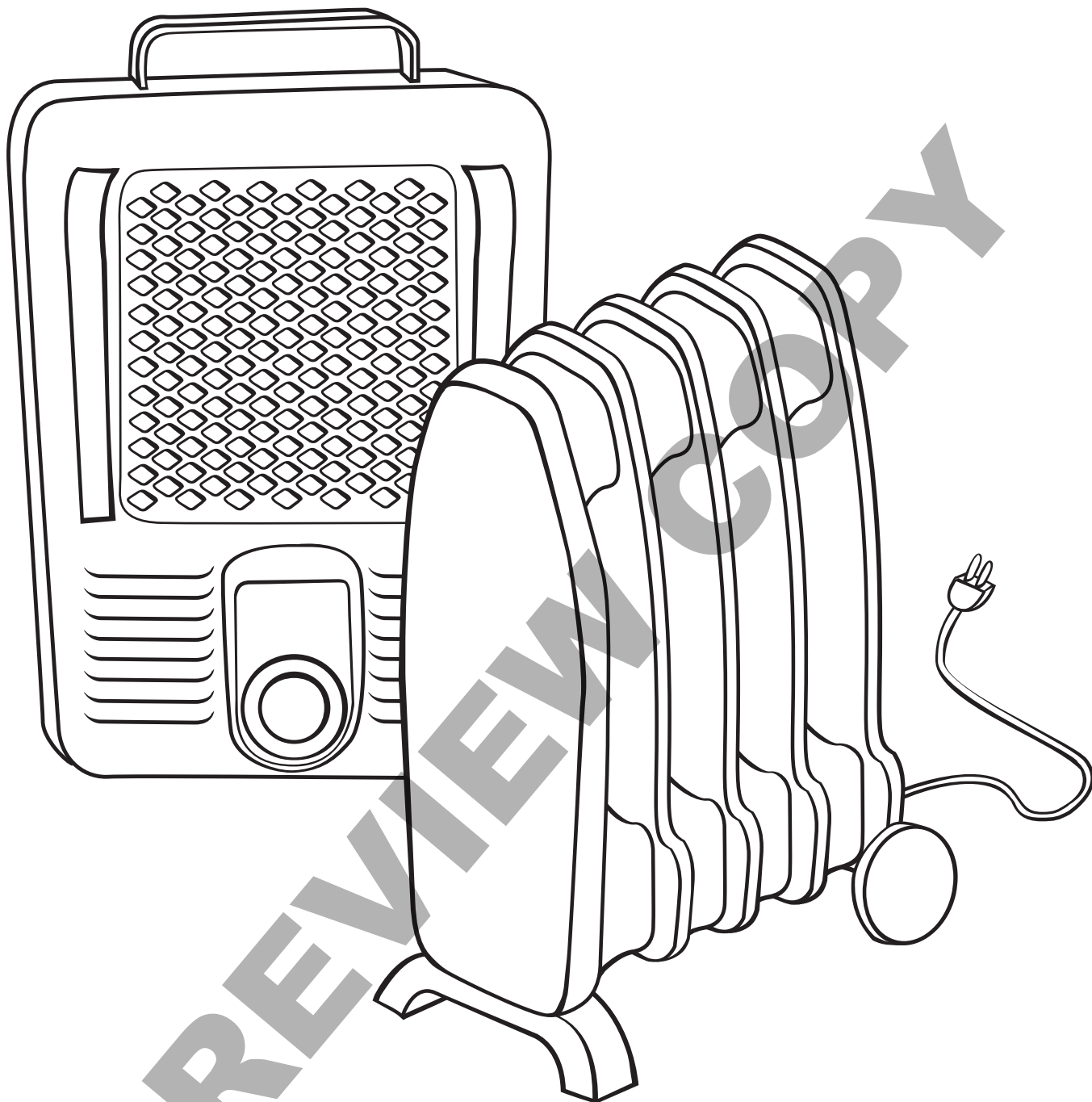
Sparks coming from a wall socket or electric cord means “danger!” Don’t wait! Tell an adult!





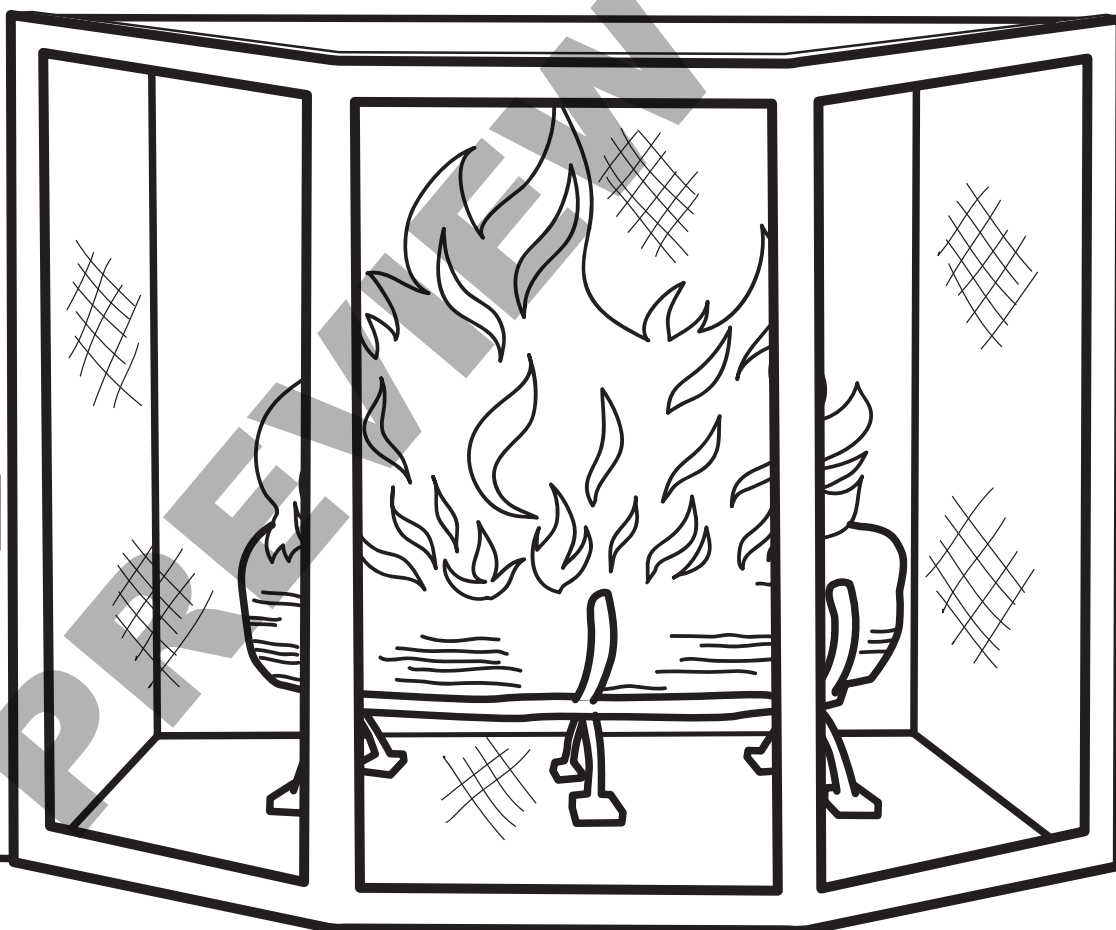
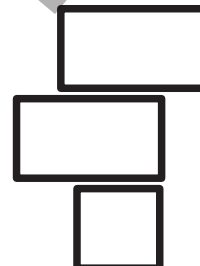
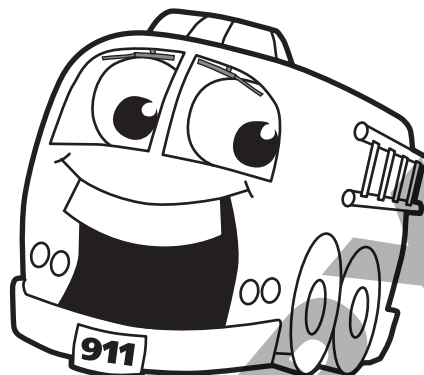
**Piles of clothes, books

burn quickly!**

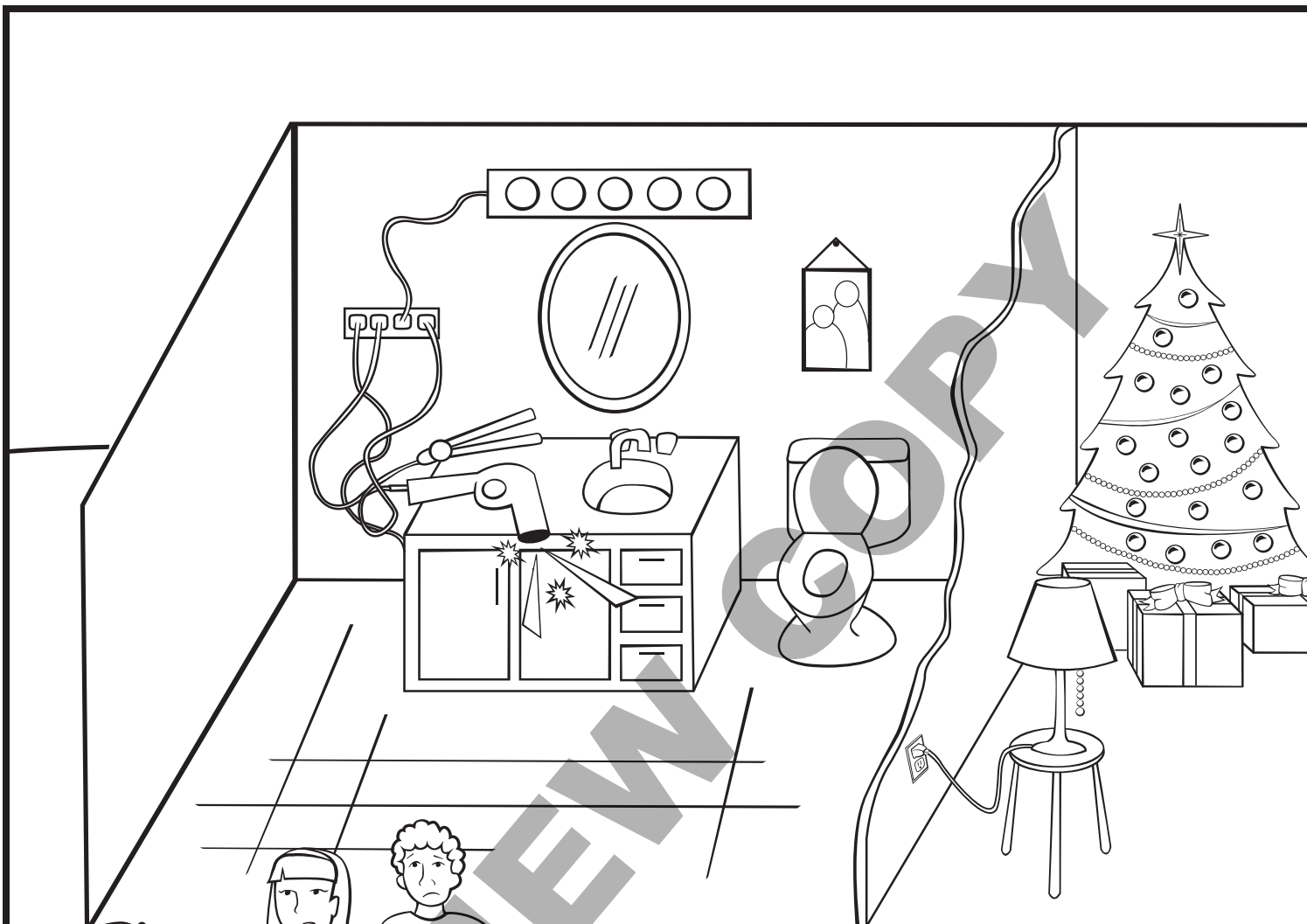




**Remind your parents to

screen in front.**





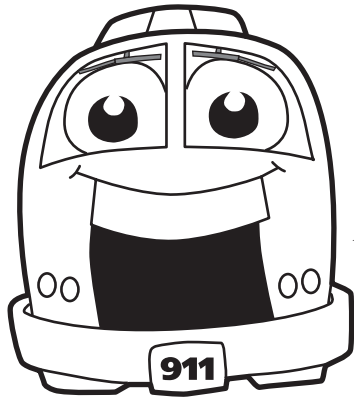

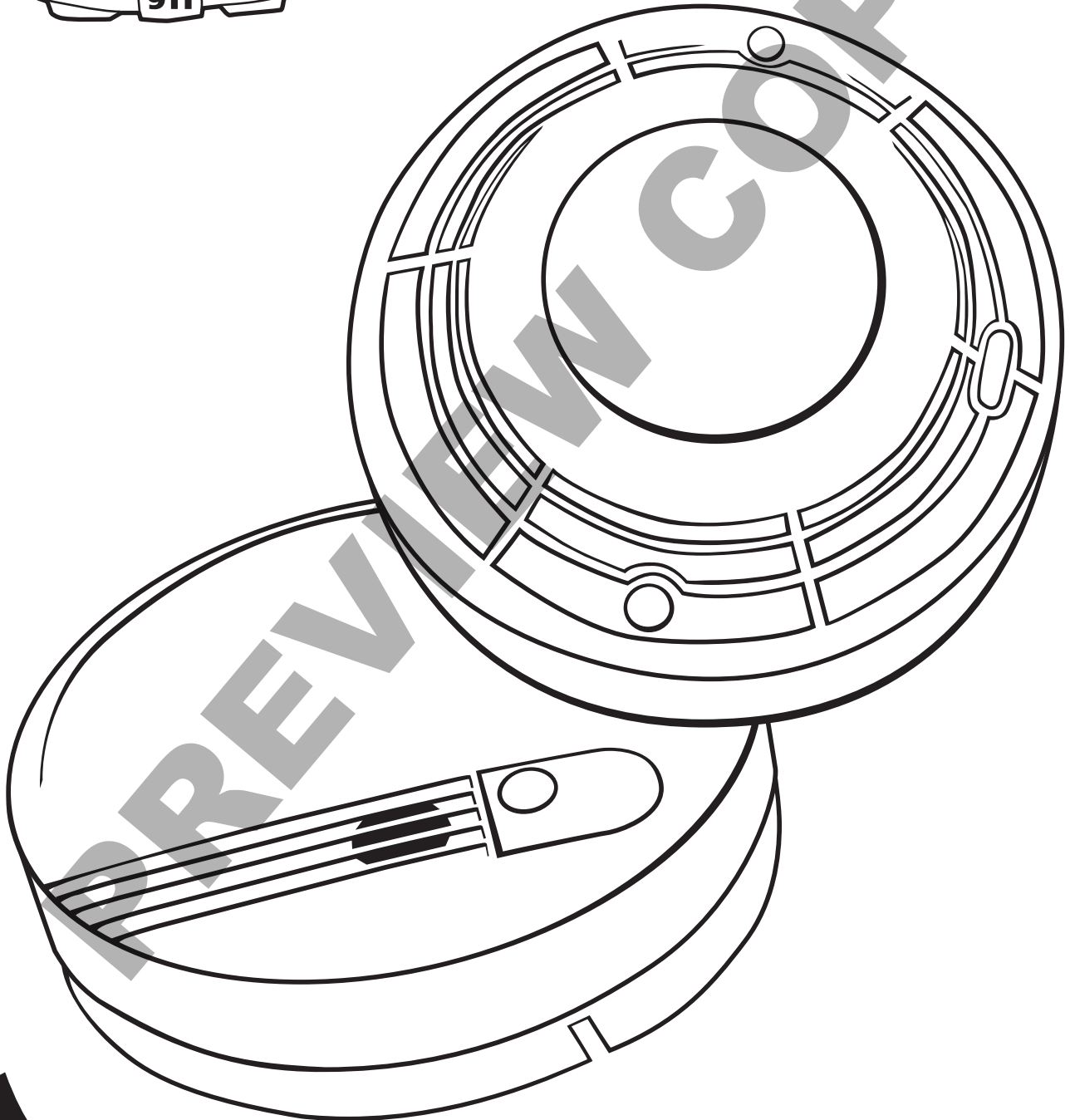

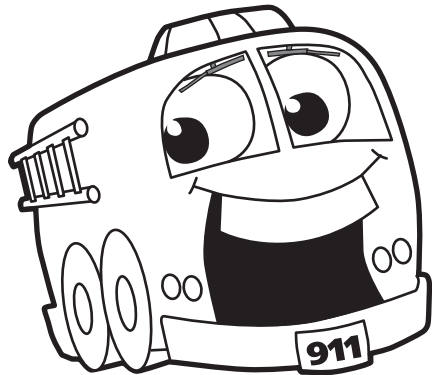


**Remind your parents to

and to test them often.**





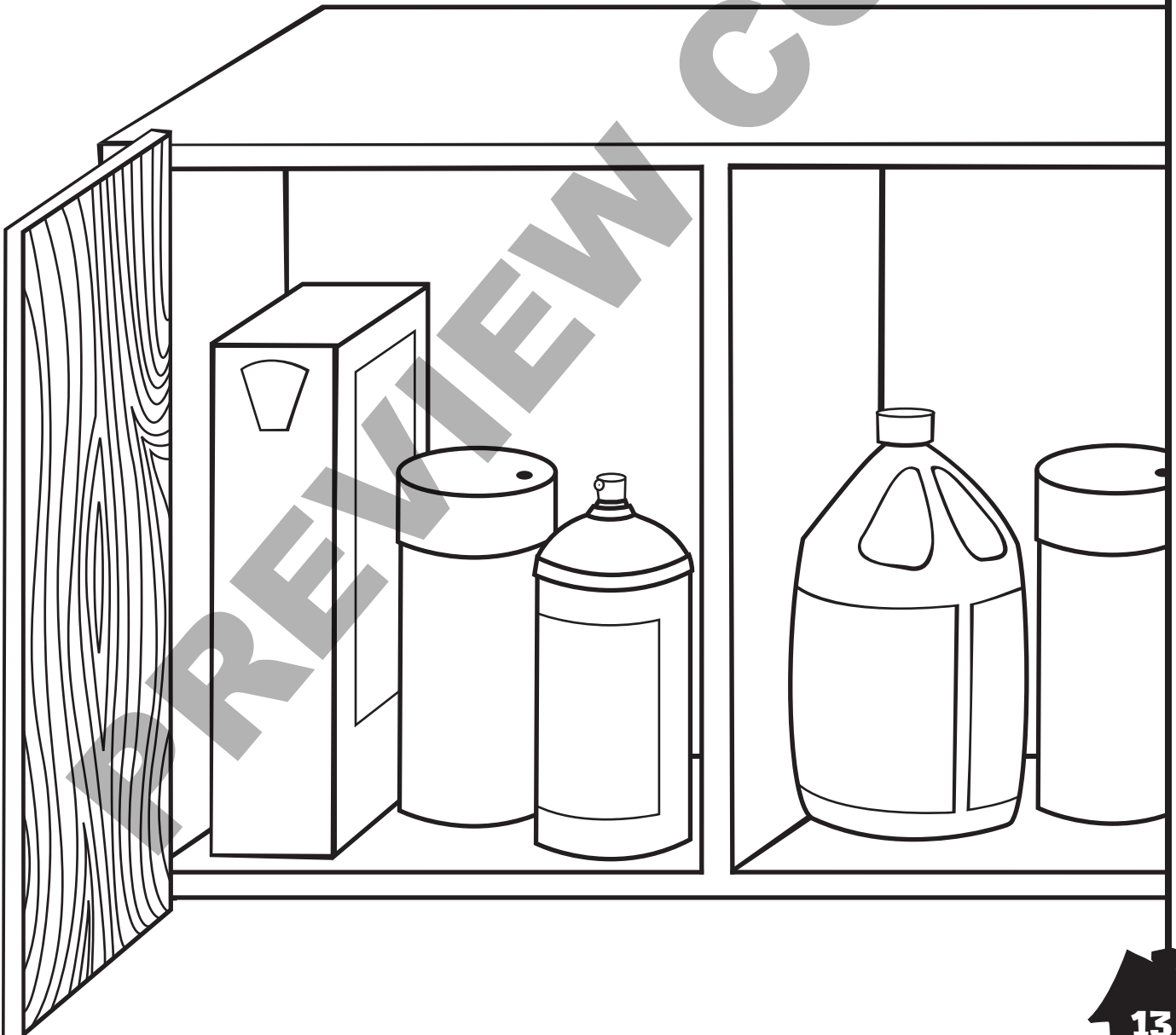
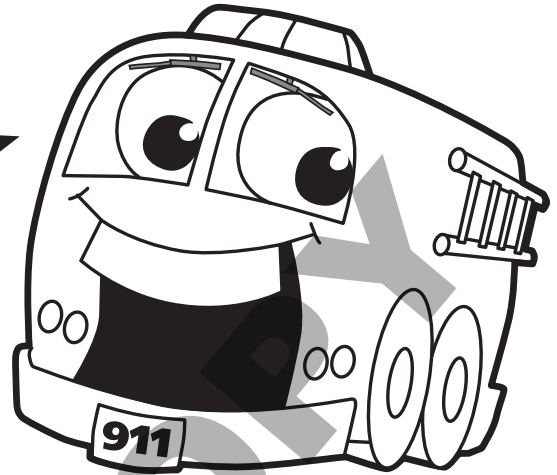
Fires outdoors can be just as dangerous as fires indoors. Piles of wood, grass and leaves near the house can be dangerous.



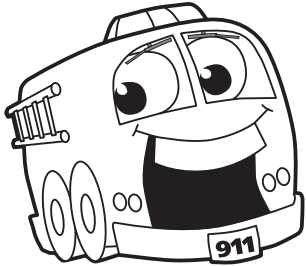
**Never play around

Cans of gasoline in the garage and chemicals under the sink in the kitchen can be dangerous. Ask your parents to move them out of the garage and house.



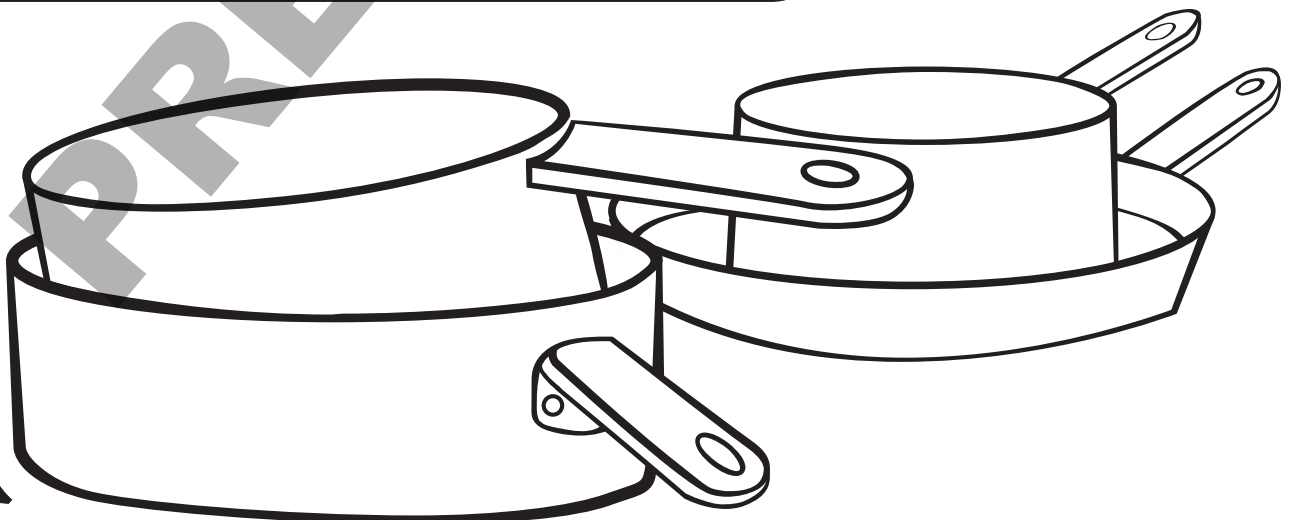
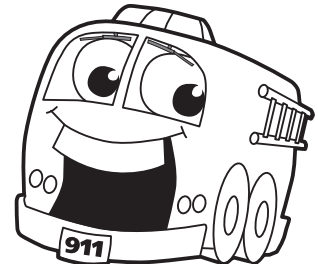
Prevent Holiday Fires!



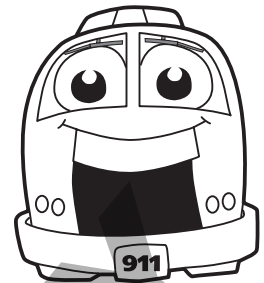
Halloween - Never use a candle in your jack-o-lantern. Use a battery powered light instead. Also, ask a parent if your costume is "fire safe!"



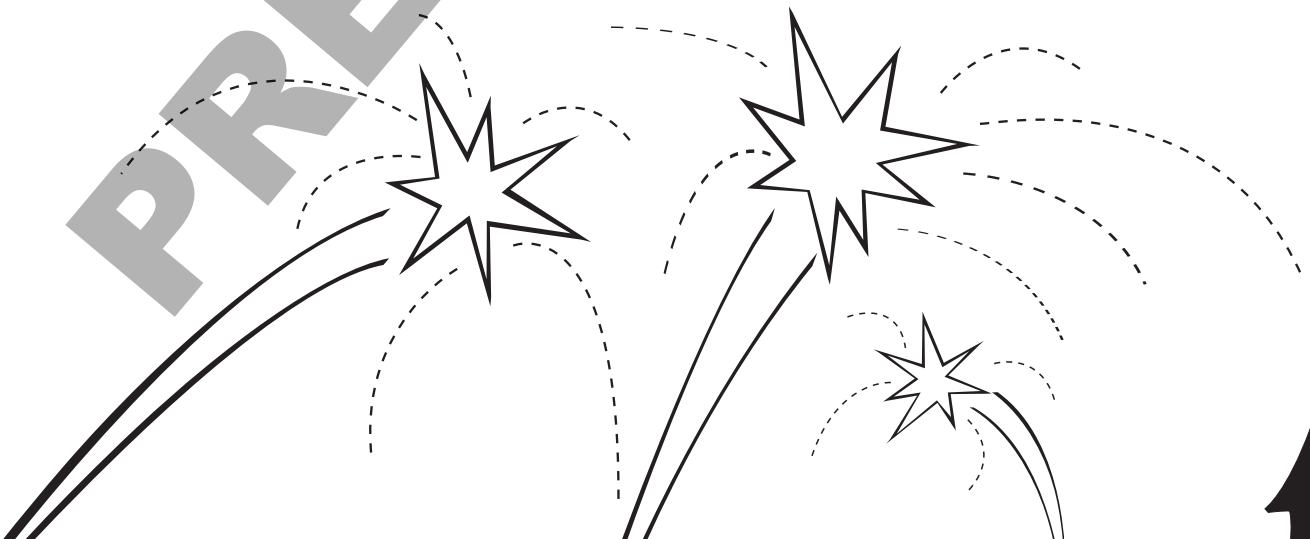
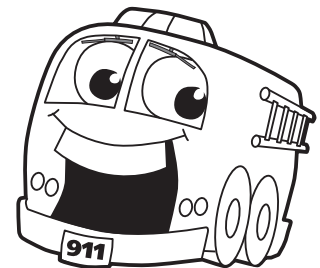
Thanksgiving - Too many pots and pans on the stove can be dangerous!
