


Always Play it Safe Inside!

Put an "X" through all the UNSAFE items in the kitchen.


 \bigwedge Never touch sharp knives or utensils.

Parents: NEVER leave loose electrical cords, hot, or sharp items within a child's reach.






Iways Play it Safe In the Bathroom!

Hot Water Can Cause Burns!


ALWAYS turn cold water on first, then the hot.






Help Prevent Scalds!

NEVER take a bath alone or play in water without a parent or adult nearby.






Tell an Adult When You See

Draw a line from the dangerous household item, to the effect it can cause.








Always Play it Safe With Electricity!

Never Use Electricity Near Water!


Connect the dots to find out what common household items should never be used near water.




· · Electricity Is Dangerous!

 Make sure electrical cords are safely stored and secured.










Medications & Poison Are

- Common household chemicals and cleaners can make you very sick.












- Parents Toxic cleaners, chemicals and medications should be out of reach or behind locked cabinets.








Important Fire Safety Tips


Smoke Alarms Warn You that There is a FIRE!



- The Know the sound your smoke alarm makes.
- \bigwedge Know what to do when a smoke alarm sounds!
- Parents Test your smoke alarms monthly and change the batteries twice a year.

Crawl Low Under Smoke!

- ☆ Smoke can be dangerous.
- Smoke rises. Crawl low to breathe good air.
- Roll out of bed instead of sitting up.
- Feel doors to see if they are hot, before opening them.



In Case of Fire - Get Out and Stay Out!

- \mathcal{L} Know two ways out of every room.
- 🖒 Have a Fire Escape Plan and Safe Meeting Spot.
- Don't hide! Get out, or go to a window and call for help.

Always Play it Safe In the Car!




Always Practice Safety While Riding in the Car!

- NEVER yell, fight or throw things.




Always Mear Your Seat Belt!


Seat Belts Help Protect You in an Accident!




NEVER place the seat belt under your arm.
